Purpose

To set fees to be charged for sale of snowploughing flags and conditions for snowploughing of driveway and lanes

Policy

The RM of Loon Lake # 561 shall snowplough lanes when requested by the property owner/ renter placing a "snowplough flag" up at the end of their lane or private drive.

Snowplough flags MUST be placed at the end of driveway prior to grader going by. If not and owner/renter wishes to have driveway ploughed, custom rates shall apply.

Snowplough flags can be purchased at the RM Office for \$50 per flag. Snowplough flags represent a maximum of 30 minutes of service and are intended solely for service to the owner's principal residence and adjacent buildings.

If any snowploughing, in the opinion of the Public Works Foreman, will take longer than 30 minutes Policy 300-04 Custom Work shall apply.

Snowploughing of driveway or lane shall be one pass going into the yard and one pass exiting the yard. Land owner must sign *Snow Removal Agreement Schedule A* at time of flag purchase.

It is responsibility of owner/renter to insure all property, animals, and persons are not where damage could occur and the RM assumes no liability for any damage caused.

Snowplough service to fields for the purpose of recovering bales, grain or other commodities shall be provided at current hourly custom rates and scheduled at the discretion of the RM public works foreman.

Exception

The RM Public Works Foreman reserves the right to refuse to snowplough driveway/lane due to availability of equipment or manpower and where conditions exist that may cause damage to the equipment or property.

Effective Date/Repeal

This policy will come into effect on April 15, 2021 unless otherwise specified and shall be implemented as outlined in this policy. This policy repeals and replaces all resolutions and any policies pertaining to Snowploughing of Driveway/Lanes and replaces all past practices. This policy may only be amended or repealed by resolution of Council.
