Old Business:

a. Hamlet Maintenance

- Lori Scheidt has purchased a pantry from IKEA for installation in the utility building. A base for the panty cabinet will have to be constructed.
- The Hamlet will offer the Wiebe's and Grassl's up to \$300/mth for use of the small trailers that Ben and Nolan have been using while doing hamlet maintenance.
- The Hamlet gas card appears to be valid at the Turtleford Coop outlets. Kevin Hauth will contact the RM office about making the card available to use at the Lloydminster Coop for premium gas.
- Keith and Lori Scheidt will design and construct a workbench/storage area for the tractor building.
- The fire and water trucks will be driven to Paradise Hill this month to ensure they are in good operating condition. They may be taken for a drive later this fall as well. Keith will attempt to siphon some diesel out of the water truck for use in the tractor. Jerry Jasper will be consulted regarding what should be done to prepare the water truck for the winter season.
- Keith Scheidt will purchase a wrench set and other assorted tools for hamlet maintenance tasks.
 The tools will be stored in the tractor building.

b. Tractor

Whether the hamlet tractor and driver should be available for rent to the residents was discussed. Kevin will contact the RM to find out what their policy is. The RM policy could be adapted for hamlet use.

c. Timesheets

Hamlet directors will submit timeslips for the hours they have worked for the Hamlet. They will be compensated at \$35/hr.

d. Parks

The Little Fishing Lake boat launch is on the Saskatchewan Parks list to be upgraded.

e. PARCs

Little Fishing Lake directors will not be attending the PARCs 2025 AGM in Regina.
