BYLAW NO. 1/2015

**A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY
OF LOON LAKE NO. 561, SASKATCHEWAN
PROHIBITING FIREWORKS**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Loon Lake No.561 enacts as follows:

The provisions of this bylaw shall apply within the limits of the Organized Hamlet of Little Fishing Lake only.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression:
 - (a) **Fireworks** shall be deemed to include squibs, firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, roman candles, sparklers and other pyrotechnics of all descriptions and also including the singular thereof;
 - (b) **Fireworks Display** shall mean a display of fireworks for the entertainment of the public at large.

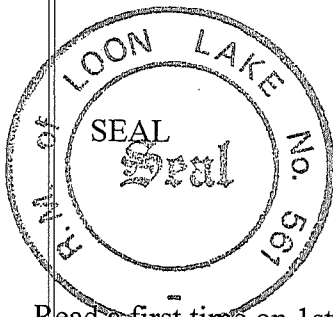
CONTROL AND SETTING OFF OF FIREWORKS


- 2. No person shall set off or allow to be set off in the limits of Little Fishing Lake any fireworks.
- 3.
 - (a) no person under the age of eighteen (18) years shall hold in his or her hand any fireworks ignited or otherwise;
 - (b) No person shall set off any fireworks in or into any highway, street, lane, square or other public place;
 - (c) No person shall set off any fireworks in or into any building, doorway, motor vehicle or other place where such setting off might create a danger to any person or property.

PENALTY


- 4. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties set out in The Fire Prevention Act of the Province of Saskatchewan, and where the said Act is not specific on an offence the provisions of the General Penalty Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Loon Lake No. 561 shall apply.

Everyone who commits an offence under this Bylaw is guilty of a summary offence and liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual and not more than \$10,000.00 for a corporation.
