Purpose

To set fees to be charged for solid waste delivered to the RM of Loon Lake No. 561 transfer site.

To set what solid waste is acceptable at the transfer site.

Set conditions by which certain wastes will be accepted.

Policy

The hours of operation will be as follows:

Summer Hours (April 1- September 30):

Sunday 12:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. Wednesday 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Thursday

Winter Hours (October 1 – March 31)

Sunday 12:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. Wednesday 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Closed all statutory holidays

The R.M. of Loon Lake No. 561 is open to all rate-payers of the Village of Loon Lake and the R.M. of Loon Lake No. 561

All waste must be sorted according to material type.

The Transfer site will NOT accept the following:

Electronics, tires, batteries, asphalt/shingles, rocks, cement, asbestos, antifreeze, paint/paint cans, fuel tanks, propane tanks, animal carcases, butchered meats or by-products, contaminated brush/soil, liquid waste or any other hazardous materials, vehicles, ATV and other motorized riding equipment, construction waste, medium and large furniture.

All construction waste must be hauled to Northwest Regional Waste Management Authority. All furniture must be hauled to Northwest Regional Waste Management Authority.

White metals must have the doors/lids and freon removed before being accepted or taken at the transfer site. If the freon is not removed the appliance will be accepted with the freon at the Rapid View Landfill.

Fees are set out in Schedule A- RM of Loon Lake No. 561 Transfer Disposal Fees and are subject to change by resolution council.

Council shall review transfer site fees annually before February 28.

Effective Date/Repeal

This policy will come into effect on July 9, 2025, unless otherwise specified and shall be implemented as outlined in this policy. This policy repeals and replaces all resolutions and any policies pertaining to Solid Waste Transfer site replaces all past practices. This policy may only be amended or repealed by resolution of Council.
